/ All About TED

TED is an annual event where some of the world's leading thinkers and doers are invited to share what they are most passionate about. "TED" stands for Technology, Entertainment, Design - three broad subject areas that are, collectively, shaping our future. And in fact, the event is broader still, showcasing ideas that matter in any discipline. Attendees have called it "the ultimate brain experience" and "a journey into the future." The diverse audience -CEOs, scientists, creatives, philanthropists- is almost as extraordinary as the speakers, who have included Bill Clinton, Bill Gates, Jane Goodall, Frank Gehry, Paul Simon, Sir Richard Branson, Philippe Starck and Bono.

/ TED* in brief

TED* is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share ideas worth spreading. At a TED^x event - where "x" stands for independently organized event - TED Conference only provides general guidance and TEDTalks, videos and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection.

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TED^x is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TED^x event, TEDTalks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection in a small group. These local, self-organized events are branded TED^x , where x = independently organized TED event. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TED* events are self-organized.

/ TED*Athens 2012

The subject for this year is "The Ones Who Do", extending invitations to visionary individuals from a variety of fields challenging commonly held preconceptions and pre-established boundaries in their field. The Ones Who Do are individuals pushing boundaries dreaming of a different world; the One Who Do seek to find ways of making their ingenuous vision an everyday reality. Any individual challenging widely-held preconceptions regarding how the world works or how the world should work redefines not only our perception of the world but also how our actions might affect the world. Our choice of subject is not only topical but urgent: we need to be active in the way we approach the world itself.
